Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall deductible?	\$7,050 individual/\$14,100 family.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Preventive care, primary care, specialist, and urgent care office visits, generic and preferred drugs are covered before you meet your deductible.
